Josefa Teixidor, a painter of flowers in the Modernist Barcelona

Abstract in English of your presentation (maximum 1,000 characters)

The aim of this communication is to remind the name of who was considered the best watercolorist of flowers at her time. A contemporary painter of Ramon Casas and Santiago Rusiñol, with those who participated in the Universal Exposition in Paris in 1900 and whose name, like that of many other women, has been forgotten. A painter who is not considered modernist but who lived and painted in the heart of modernism, why her participation and her place in the artistic movement of the moment were not recognized? Despite the current lack of knowledge and the poor assessment of her work, Josefa had the rare privilege of enjoying the critics and the public's favor, and she was able to see her art being recognized in life, and to receive an unthinkable tribute on her decease in the Barcelona of the early Twentieth Century; a monument was erected in the Ciudadela Park which still stands. A monument very important, it is the first erected to woman, with her full name, family name and her own job. She is not a muse. She is an actual woman.
