The Block of Discord: a project for a cross-disciplinary group of research

The Research Group "History, architecture and design" was created in 1998, in the Architectural Composition Area of the School of Architecture (ESARQ) of the Universitat Internacional de Catalunya (UIC). Last year, this group, formed by Architects, Art Historians, Heritage managers won the call for novel investigation that offers the University, with an external evaluation from the AGAUR (Agència de Gestió d'Ajuts Universitaris i de Recerca: Management of grants for university and research agency), "The Block of discord: Art Nouveau as a transgression in the regularity of the Eixample". In this project, an investigation of the five houses that form the block was proposed under different aspects: historic, socio-cultural context, urban planning, owners of the buildings, masons, façades, interior layout plans, construction, ornamentation, planning regulations and ordinances and their enforcement and restoration. Some activities were also proposed for divulgation: a seminar, an exhibition and a monographic book among them.
